Dear Dr. Adams:

This letter is to give advance warning and notice to you about a public health crisis that matters to everyone; namely: Commencing and continuing contiguously from at least as far back as September 11, 1986, the United States governing bodies, top to bottom, across the board, federal, state, local, and their reciprocal benefactors/aiders and abettors have waged war against my parents Ruth Elvada Denniston Blevins (1923-1997) and Robert Frank Blevins (1925-2011) and theirs, against my sister Constance B. "Connie" Cieszynski (1947-2017) and hers, against me and mine and others. Having murdered my mother, my father, and my sister, they continue murdering certain other of my parents' survivors, including my son Josiah Robert Fornof (1980-) and me, Kimberly Ann Blevins (1956-). Their primary murder weapon of choice is stress, strain, and mental anguish unlawfully brought to bear against my family and me through their unlawfulness, including through their treason and genocide. I am disabled as a direct result of said war.

Said war has vast implications, including but in no manner limited to as I have put forth in my letter dated February 11, 2018, to the U.S. Permanent Representative to the United Nations, a copy of which is enclosed for your reference. I ask that you address this matter lawfully in the fulness of your rank and title, both as Vice Admiral and as Surgeon General of the United States.
